

Restorative Practices in Schools Continuing Education Options

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1. *University of San Diego* in California. Center for Restorative Justice. RJ training for individuals online or in-person or for organizations. They offer Restorative Justice for Higher Education, Sexual Harm (Title IX), Training for Restorative Justice in Academic Healthcare, and Restorative Practices Training for K-12 Educators. **NEW:** Restorative Justice Facilitation and Leadership Certificate that includes three required courses developed by the University of San Diego's Center for Restorative Justice. 5. *Vermont Law & Graduate School* in South Royalton. Center for Justice Reform. Students gain the skills to become agents for change within the justice system.
